Mariquita, Central Valley, Chile (1)
Zesty with ripe lemons and tropical flavours. **F & C**
3. **Chardonnay** £25.75
Select Reserve Patterson's, Australia (3)
An abundance of ripe apples, zesty citrus and stone fruits are present on the palate with a clean finish. **P, C & F**
4. **Pinot Gris** £27.50
La Cour Des Dames, French (2)
