Fragrant aromas of white flowers, lime leaf and white peach. The refined palate combines juicy citrus and supple, ripe apple flavours with a creamy peach quality, underpinned by a flinty minerality. Lithe and elegant.

Cave de Cléebourg, Gewurztraminer, Alsace

2020 £50.00

An exotic blend of lychee and delicate honeyed fruits, Turkish delight and a fresh rose finish. Lightly spiced and full bodied, the refreshing acidity makes for a perfect balance.

Domaine de la Jobeline, Chardonnay, Macon-Villages

2019 £62.00

While revealing notes of quince, crushed pear and small notes of vanilla associated with small touches of citrus and a very discreet hint of fresh flowers, minerality and ripe almond, this wine finishes on a good length, and with zesty persistence.

Complex aromas of black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon. Medium bodied, with dried fruit notes fresh red berries and sweet spice on the palate

La Combe de Grinou, Merlot-Cabernet, IGP Perigord

2021 £35.50

This is an alluring, soft and supple red blend. Light in colour, with smoky strawberry, crushed loganberry and dried herb notes, the wine is juicy and appealing. Very easy to drink.

Chateau La Grave de Bertin Cuvée, Bordeaux, Merlot

2019 £36.00

This Merlot has a very aromatic bouquet of ripe plum and fig fruits. The palate is dense, with rich tannins a long and smooth finish and very well-balanced.

Vignobles Gonnet, Côtes-du-Rhône

2020 £46.00

Beautiful, garnet red in colour with violet, chocolate and dried herb notes on the nose. More of the same on the palate, balanced perfectly with spicy liquorice, dark fruit and a fresh acidity. Rustic, yet elegant on the finish, this wine is exceptionally well made.

Château Lafon, Cru Bourgeois, Listrac-Medoc

2018 £54.00

Rich and complex, it offers an array of floral aromas, from violet to sweet peony, prunes, toast and vanilla. It has finely tannic elegance with a lingering and bright finish.

Château Saint Aubin, Cru Bourgeois, Médoc, Bordeaux

2019 £60.00

Rich and complex, it offers a range of floral aromas, from violet to sweet peony, prunes, toast and vanilla. It has finely tannic elegance with a lingering and bright finish.

Beauregard has a nose revealing complex aromas of blackcurrant, sweet spices and mint. The tannins are silky and smooth, and the wine has a long and mouth-watering finish.
